Her aim is to start every puppy and their families off on the right 'paw' and set them up for success in their new homes to prevent unwanted behaviours before they even occur.

### Week.1.

- Puppy Free—human information night about a range of topics such as toilet training, mouthing, enrichment and how they learn.

### Week.2.

- We learn to sit, swap & leave it
- Calming techniques
- Name recognition & to go to their mat

### Week.3.

- We learn drop & stand
- Puppy handling techniques– training for co-operative care
- Discuss diet– what to feed & what to avoid

### Week.4.

- Extension of previously taught behaviours
- Learn a trick for graduation
- What our dogs were originally bred for & how this affects us.
- Discuss jumping & meal time manners

### Graduation

- Discussion on de-sexing, growth & appropriate exercise
- Come/Recall training
- Responsible pet ownership
- Perform all tricks learnt & graduate together :)

### What to bring:



#### WEEK ONE– INFORMATION NIGHT

- Payment (Cash only)
- Student profile (if not already handed in)
- Vaccination certificate (if not already been sighted by staff)

#### ALL OTHER WEEKS
